

3D: DISCOVER PT 4

Five Facets of a Disciple

Take time to open in prayer with the anticipation and the expectation of the Holy Spirit revealing His will through His word.

Recap

Take time with your group to recap the message you heard. What was the message about? Did you have any “Ah-Ha” moments (did you feel convicted, compelled, or inspired during the sermon)? Encourage each other to express any questions regarding the message and try to Biblically address them throughout the study. Keep the focus on the contents of the message.

Holy Scripture:

WORSHIP “It is written, you shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve.” Luke 4:7

GROW “the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.” Luke 8:15

SERVE “You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, **serve one another humbly in love.**” Galatians 5:13

REACH “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” Matthew 28:19-20

REPRODUCE “and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” 2 Timothy 2:2

Diving Deeper

The five facets show what Christ intends for His disciples to do and be.

Though we have not fully discussed Develop and Deploy, how would you think Discover, Develop, and Deploy help you find your five?

Discover, Develop, and Deploy helps us understand who God is, who we are, what we do, and how we do it

Why is each of the five important to being a complete disciple of Christ?

For instance, why is reproduce important? Because your discipleship cannot end with you. Why is worship important? Because you need to acknowledge God's preeminence and fellowship with Him.

Whats your Belmont? Where do you worship, grow, serve, reach, and reproduce at Belmont?

Which of the five is a strength in your life at this moment or you enjoy the most?

Which of the five is your weakest or needs to develop?

What are some things you have discovered about God that motivate you to worship, grow, serve, reach, and reproduce?

Example: Worship - Psalm 47:6-7 Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises! For God is the King of all the earth; sing praises with a psalm! Serve – I discovered that I find fulfillment in serving Him. Reach – I discovered the grace of Christ in His death and resurrection can save the lost, so I reach them.

Though we will talk about this in Develop, how do you personally share your faith?

What does it look like to reproduce a disciple of Christ?
